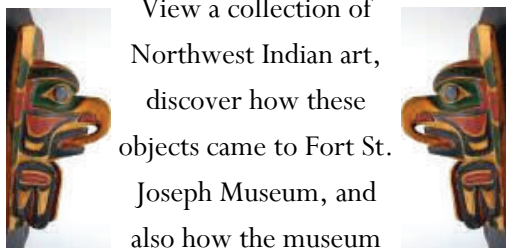


SPECIAL OVERNIGHT PROGRAM:

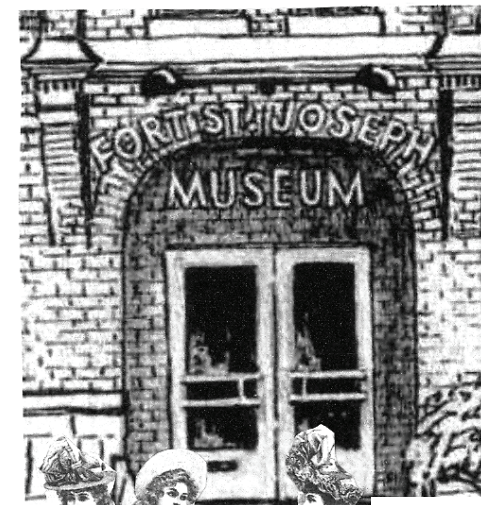

INTEREST WORKSHOPS 2010-2011

WOMEN THROUGH TIME
