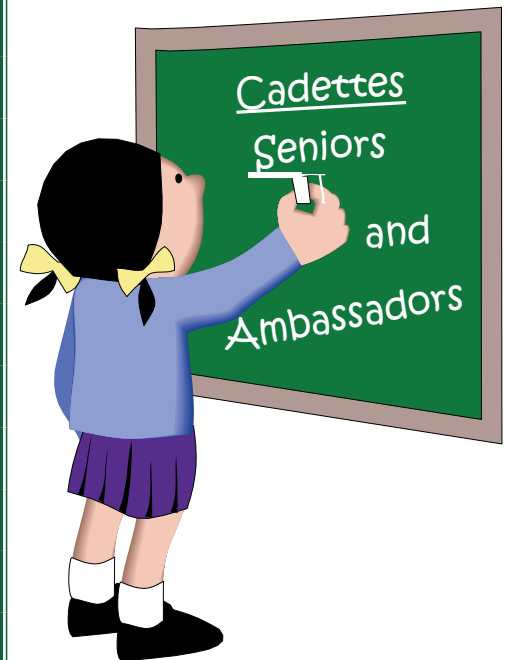

WOMEN THROUGH TIME
