EARN TWO TRY-ITS IN 2 HOURS!

LISTEN TO THE PAST AND THE UNDERGROUND RAILROAD

Learn about slavery and the Underground Railroad. Discover why the Underground Railroad in Michigan was so well traveled. Make some crafts, explore our Underground Railroad exhibit, and tour the Silverbrook Cemetery. \$8.00 per child. Minimum of 6 girls. \$48 non-refundable deposit.

Underground Railroad Program *Junior*

Learn the history of the Underground Railroad. What was it? When did it start? Examine the words to "Follow the Drinking Gourd", explore the routes that fugitive slaves took and learn why Michigan was such a well traveled state. Create a quilt square, and go on a history hunt.

Fort St. Joseph - Brownies and Juniors
Discover what it was like living at a colonial fort. Learn about the different countries that occupied the site in Niles, MI. What did the people do, how long did they stay, why did they leave?
