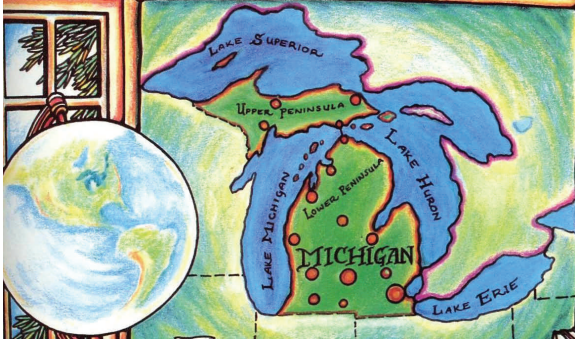


Michigan History
