Historic Chapin Mansion Opens for Tours

Niles, MI – An open house will be held on April 4th to kick off the 2015 tour season for the Historic Chapin Mansion. Hours will be 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and there will be no admission fee. Visitors will guide themselves through the mansion. Docents (trained tour guides) will be posted throughout the first and second floors of the house to answer questions and point out changes that have occurred in the mansion during the past three months.

Starting April 10, 2015 guided tours will be conducted on Fridays and Saturdays at 11:30 a.m. and 1:30p.m. Admission fee will be \$5.00 for ages 10 and up.

The Historic Chapin Mansion was built in 1882 by Henry and Ruby Chapin. The Chapin's earned their fortune through the iron ore industry in Michigan's Upper Peninsula. The mansion, located at 508 E. Main Street, Niles, is built in the American Aesthetic style and features stunning stained glass windows, interior wood carving, fireplaces and chandeliers.
